PLUM COULEE MARCH 2026 POLICE ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

On the 6th of March Police received a call from a resident in Plum Coulee advising her husband was suicidal and just took off from their house possibly headed to Lowe Farm area. Police were able to receive information showing live tracking of the male as he operated his motor vehicle. Tracking showed the vehicle was now headed to Winkler. Winkler Police were advised and located the vehicle and driver. After a short vehicle pursuit, the driver was taken into custody by Winkler Police. The male was assessed at a local Medical Facility and cleared back to police. He was charged with several driving related offences and will appear in court at a later date.

On the 9th of March Police were called to an apartment complex in Plum Coulee due to excessive noise from a neighboring suite. Police were advised by the complainant that the neighbors always have their TV on so loud it disturbs them. Police spoke to the neighbors who advised they did not know it was bothering anyone and voluntarily turned it down and advised they would not turn it up.

On the 11th of March Police received a call from the ankle monitoring corporation to advise that a Plum Coulee resident who is on court order to wear an ankle monitor due to being on house arrest, has left his residence. Police were advised that the adult male from Plum Coulee was out looking for his dog. Police contacted the individual and warned him to return home as he was breaching the conditions of his Community Sentence Order. The assigned Probation Officer will follow up with the individual.
